- * Hold a **car wash or yard sale** and advertise that all proceeds go to the Walk
- * Host a **bake sale or lunch-time dessert buffet** at work and donate proceeds to the Walk
- * Ask **folks you worship with** to donate

Fundraising Ideas To Help Your Team Raise Money

1) Set a goal.

Think big! We encourage teams to raise a minimum of about \$100 per member. Some teams set their goal lower, and many set it higher. Some even surpass their goal and just keep on going! We are appreciative of donations of any size.

2) Set up online fundraising pages and give out sponsorship forms.
